

INTRODUCTION

A successful period calls for a celebration. A celebration to show appreciation for the protection we've enjoyed throughout the years and spiritual purification for the years ahead.

A heritage passed down since the victory against the Asantes in 1835. The people of Akropong-Akuapem, Aburi, Larteh and Mamfe come together to embrace and celebrate their heritage bringing from far and near people from all walks of life to join them during this august occasion.

The festival, once again opened its doors to people of the land and well-wishers from Ghana as well as Africans across the diaspora and the global community at large to immerse themselves in the way of life of people in the FanteAkwa district of the Eastern Region of Ghana.

This year, oneness through our heritage takes us on a journey to experience all the deep culture, traditions and customs that have come to forge a rich heritage and shows how all these elements share a ONE unique aim in the community.

OUR STORY, OUR HERITAGE

The festival was initiated by the 19th Okuapehene of Akropong, Nana Addo Dankwa I who ruled from 1811 to 1835. First celebrated in October 1826, it has continued to be celebrated every year in respect and appreciation to the Ancestors. It's significance is linked to the victory of the people of Okuapeman over the then-powerful Ashanti army during the historic battle of Katamansu near Dodowa in 1826.

Odwira is a time of spiritual cleansing, when the people of Okuapeman, and all who celebrate, present themselves anew and pray for protection.

Traditionally, the timing of the festival also coincides with the harvest season when there is abundant food; during which time the people give thanks to the Ancestors. Being a Yam Festival, gratitude for the harvest is especially expressed in 'feeding the ancestors'.

During the Festival, bowls of mashed yam (some mixed with palm oil and others left white) which have been specially prepared by the Okuapehene and other stool occupants and carried in procession from the Ahemfi to feed the ancestors at Nsorem.

A little-known fact is, the Odwira Festival is also celebrated by the Ga people of Jamestown in the Greater Accra Region of Ghana as a result of their long association with the Akans through intermarriages.
